





## Weddings



# SERVICE



## Ministry Teams

Our congregation is “run” by various teams that plan and execute our entire ministry plan. Each team is formed and operates independently according to its tasks. To learn more and to join, email [pastor@holytrinityut.org](mailto:pastor@holytrinityut.org).

**Church Council:** Our governing team. Ensures following of our constitution and by-laws and recommends budgets to the rest of our family.

**Deacons:** This group works with pastor to help plan and coordinate all things in worship. They also provide valuable assistance and council to the pastor as they call on comfort and pray for the members of our family.

**Study:** The study of the Bible and various doctrinal matters is organized and supervised by pastor.

**Fellowship:** Overseeing all our food, fun, and guest relations that we find valuable, especially for our guests and visitors.

**Service:** Volunteers coordinate and provide outreach to a variety of community service organizations.

**School:** Our School Board makes decisions about the budget, staffing, and the business of our Learning Center and Elementary grade school.

**Staff:** Provides for all of the functions of the school and learning center and deals with the day-to-day tasks of producing worship folders, ordering necessary materials, etc.

## External Service

**LWML (Lutheran Women’s Missionary League)** 1st Saturday every month

The LWML is an official auxiliary of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod. Its mission is to joyfully proclaim Christ, support missions, and equip women to honor God by serving others. Every Holy Trinity lady is a member of LWML and is invited to gather monthly for prayer, devotions, food, service projects, and fellowship.

Our church has the opportunity to help fund LCMS missions all over the world.

# Financial Plan

## EXPENSES

### **\$150,000** Personnel

Holy Trinity employs a pastor, Administrator, and Organists. *Other staff are included in the school's ministry budget.*

### **\$36,000** Operations

Our ministries operate with these funds, covering everything from copy machines to communion wine, event production costs, and other ministry supplies.

### **\$459,600** Property

Our campus and facilities are a gift from God, and we do our best to maximize their ministry use. This cost includes mortgage, utilities, and facility expenses.

### **\$42,080** Benevolences

We support various ministries worldwide, as noted in our Ministry Plan.
